І. Введение

Согласитесь, невозможно представить жизнь без пословиц -метких образных изречений, обобщающих различные явления жизни и имеющих назидательный смысл. В довольно-таки кратком высказывании содержится глубокий смысл, а также отражается народная мудрость, основанная на историческом опыте, стремления и идеалы, оценки и убеждения о самых разных сторонах жизни. Пословицы делают любое высказывание выразительным и образным. Пословицы не только украшают и обогащают любой язык. Они являются отражением истории, жизни народа, его культуры и менталитета. Это и объясняет неослабевающий интерес пословицам на протяжении долгого времени. Современное общество стремительно меняется. Естественно, что язык не может не отражать все эти изменения .Нас заинтересовало явление, которое сейчас набирает популярность, особенно в английском языке. Мы считаем, что анти пословицы в английском языке, действительно представляют немалый интерес и с лингвистической точки зрения, и с социокультурной. Есть немало вопросов, на которые всем интересно, и полезно найти ответы, например,- почему, где и как появляются анти пословицы? Почему они уживаются с традиционными пословицами и становятся популярными? А чему они могут научить? Могут ли школьники использовать их на уроках?

Кроме того, изучение данной темы способствует к расширению кругозора и словарного запаса. Всем этим и обусловлена **актуальность** нашей темы исследования.

Задачи:

II. Основная часть Анти пословицы и пословицы английского языка: дружба или конкуренция

1 .Пословицы английского языка: определение, появление, употребление

Пословицы и поговорки называют «жемчужинами народной речи». Фрэнсис Бэкон писал: "The genius, the spirit, the character of the people are manifested in his proverbs" «Гений, дух, характер народа проявляются в его пословицах». А.С. Пушкин считал, что пословицы - «весёлое лукавство ума, насмешливость и живописный способ выражаться».. Пословицы — это совокупность правил и норм поведения, в которой отображается моральный и культурный кодекс, который регламентирует отношения людей.

Почти все пословицы появились как итог наблюдений за реальными событиями, они вмещают в себя многовековой жизненный и культурный опыт народа, оценивают и определяют поведение и деятельность человека. Пословицы изучали на протяжении долгого времени, можно дать много определений пословиц В толковом словаре Ожегова, например, «пословица-это краткое народное изречение с назидательным содержанием, народный афоризм». (7) В Википедии «пословица-малая форма народного поэтического творчества, облачённая в краткое, ритмизованное изречение, несущее общественную мысль, вывод, иносказание с дидактическим уклоном», но все определения схожи в том, что пословица- это краткое нравоучительное изречение, твердая истина, которую не нужно доказывать. Английские пословицы образовались следующими способами:

- народное творчество
- литературные произведения, причем особое место занимают Шекспиризмы
- Библия
- заимствования

• высказывания известных людей

Пословицы отражают и все лингвистическое разнообразие и богатство языка. Пословицы помогают разобраться с любой конкретной бытовой или жизненной ситуацией, понимать окружающий мир и совершать поступки. Некоторые считают, что пословицы выходят из моды, превращаются в избитую мысль, но нельзя не признать тот факт, что популярность и употребление пословиц осталось неизменным. В современном обществе продолжают их использовать довольно широко:

- в литературных произведениях
- в учебных пособиях
- в музыкальных произведениях различных жанров
- в средствах массовой информации
- реклама и слоганы компаний
- различных сферах бизнеса, особенно в экономике

2. Определение антипословиц

Очевидно, что хотя с течением времени язык и претерпевает существенные изменения, что-то устаревает и выходит из употребления, что-то новое появляется, но пословицы все так же широко используются в современном английском языке для достижений различных целей. (8)

Если роль традиционных пословиц по-прежнему значительная, как же относиться к появлению анти пословиц?

Любой язык в мире является живым организмом, который реагирует на все изменения, происходящие в общественной, культурной, политической, экономической жизни людей. Любое значимое событие, особенно мирового

масштаба, находит свое отражение в языке. Это приводит к появлению анти пословиц, в которых небольшие изменения несут новый смысл и отражают отношение носителя языка к тому или иному объекту или явлению.

Оказываясь в какой-то новой ситуации, человек сравнивает ее с уже известной, так появляется суждение с измененным значением, т.е. анти пословиц, термин впервые ввел Вольфганг Мидер в 1982. В последние годы процесс «пародирования» настолько интенсифицировался, что сформировался целый пласт особого языкового материала. Позднее у anti proverbs появились и другие названия- perverb (perverse + proverb), квазипословицы, видоизмененные пословицы ,twisted wisdom (1)

3. Причины появления антипословиц и способ их образований

Анти пословицы появляются в результате намеренного искажения известных пословиц, причем это искажение преследует определенные цели.

Среди причины появления анти пословиц можно выделить следующие:

- > отказ от клишированных фраз, поиск нового
- > отрицание или критика сложившихся стереотипов
- ирония по поводу новых явлений и условий жизни
- проявление дерзости и протеста к сложившимся авторитетным суждениям
- желание разнообразить монотонность повседневности с помощью юмора и смеха
- > проявление творчества, языковая игра
- создание комического эффекта восприятия действительности, чтобы получить положительные эмоции даже от отрицательных факторов

Пословицы отражают языковую картину мира, способствуя закреплению языкового, а значит и культурного её своеобразия в видении мира и его

обозначения средствами языка и особенности мышления человека как носителя той или иной культуры.

Анти пословицы образуются с помощью намеренного изменения традиционных пословиц. (5) Способы этих изменений следующие:

➤ так называемый, crossing proverbs, две пословицы смешиваются и образуют одну с новым значением

Например, A chatting bird builds no nest + No song, no supper => No song, no nest

Practice makes perfect + Nobody is perfect => If practice makes perfect and nobody is perfect then why practice?

 замена компонента или части традиционной пословицы, что ведет к появлению нового смысла, связанного с современной действительностью

If at first do not succeed, try and try again => If at first do not succeed, you are fired

Man proposes, God disposes => Man proposes, mother-in-law disposes

Early to bed, early to rise makes a man healthy, wealthy and wise => Early to
bed, early to rise makes a man socially dead

Таким образом, из таблицы видно, что самым популярным способом образования анти пословиц является замена компонента или части традиционной пословицы

4. Тематическая классификация антипословиц в английском языке

Анти, как и традиционные пословицы представляют огромный интерес для изучения не только с точки зрения лингвистики, но и материальной и духовной культуры народа, особенности мышления человека на современном этапе Как и оригинальные пословицы, трансформы охватывают все стороны жизни англичан. Мы сделали подборку анти пословиц в английском языке (152 примера) и проанализировали их тематику.

Тема отношения к женщине и к браку в целом оказалась одной из популярных тем.

Beware of Greek bearing gifts => Beware of women bearing gifts: remember Eve

Never marry for money => Never marry for money, but marry where money is

Behind every successful man is a woman => Behind every successful man is a woman who wanted a mink

Maidens should be meek till they be married => Maidens should be meek till they be married and then they may burn kirk

All we need is love =>Love is not all we need, all we need is fur coats, rings, and cars

Данные примеры демонстрируют утрату бережного отношения к женщине и браку и уважения к ним. А современное отношение к браку преподносится как что-то негативное, основанное на материальном интересе. Кроме того мы нашли несколько примеров, которые отражают феминистические настроения современных американок, их стремление к независимости.

Данные примеры иллюстрируют изменение отношения к добродетелям человека и его моральным качествам в худшую сторону. В них меньше верят, честность, например, расценивают, как наивность, неприспособленность.

Тема компьютера и современных технологий не могла не отразиться в анти пословицах, поскольку современный англичанин не представляет своё существование без них.

В любой национальной культуре вопросы, касающиеся человеческих взаимоотношений, таких как любовь и дружба, всегда имели и до сих пор имеют первостепенное значение. Неудивительно, что особое место и популярность в английской фразеологии занимают пословицы о дружбе и любви. При всей своей закрытости и сдержанности англичане всегда дорожили дружбой. Современное английское представление о друге требует от него гораздо меньшего; это скорее человек, с которым ,а не для которого, хочется делать что-нибудь хорошее, теперь дружеское расположение уже не предполагает обязательные и верность, и готовность помочь вплоть до самопожертвования.

В следующую группу мы включили анти пословицы, в которых отражено отношение современного общества англичан к деньгам.

Money isn't everything => Money isn't everything— there's always diamonds Таким образом, акцент делается на то, что деньги- главная сила в этом мире, но отношение к ним, как к источнику бед, зла, пороков, не изменилось. Ряд анти пословиц выделяет дороговизну всего в обществе: покупки, всевозможные платежи превышают доходы, денег постоянно не хватает.

Two heads are not better than one => Two heads are not better than one considering the present price of hair cut

Тематическая классификация данной подборки показала, что большинство тем в традиционных пословицах продолжается в их антиподах . Но вместе с тем, мы видим , что в анти пословицах появилось отражение реалий современной жизни, того, чего не существовало раньше- проблемы парковки, обслуживания , лишнего веса и-за гиподинамии, нечестности политиков и

других аспектов повседневной жизни современной Великобритании и Америки.

5. Случаи использования антипословиц в английском языке.

Особенная черта анти пословиц в том, что они с одной стороны представляют собой устойчивую незыблемость, а с другой стороны очень гибкие. Поэтому вместе с традиционными пословицами анти пословицы широко используются в английском языке, отражая все изменения в современном обществе- социальные, экономические, культурные и т.п, а так же и отражая отношение говорящего к этим явлениям. (3)

Немало случаев употребления можно встретить в сфере коммерческой рекламы.

Different sores must have different salves => Different strokes for different folks => Different volks for different folks. Когда-то английскую пословицу «Для каждой болячки нужен свой бальзам» чернокожее население юга Америки переделало в «У каждого народа свой ход», а 1970-х автомобильный концерн "Volkswagen", внеся свои изменения, использовал в своей рекламной кампании.

Absence makes the heart grow fonder => Not only absence makes the heart grow fonder.(реклама шоколада Godiva Chocolatier) (4)

You cannot teach old dogs new tricks => At D & D Dogs, you can teach an old dog new tricks" (реклама американского предприятия быстрого питания D & D Dogs) (4)

В речи различных политических деятелей по- прежнему нередко можно услышать известные и понятные пословицы, но с внесенными в них изменениями .

(No pain, yet gain =>) No pain, yet gain?: Learning from vicarious crises in an international context.

(Evil and Death do not have the final say. =>) Evil and terrorists do not have the final play (2)

В средствах массовой информации анти пословицы используются в качестве заголовков

(Dogs die for life =>) Followers will kill and die for their leader and belief.

Автор статьи хотел показать, что отношение последователей главаря террористов к своему лидеру можно сравнить с преданностью собаки, что это и составляет всю их жизнь.

(Come through the gate of horn =>) Come through the days of horn

В традиционных пословицах происходит замена какого-то компонента и расширение ее, таким образом новая пословица сохраняет сложенный когда-то в нее смысл, но становится более эмоциональной и заставляет читателей и слушателей оставаться в постоянном напряжении.

В анти пословицах отражается и критикуется все, что происходит в современной жизни. С развитием широких простор Интернета они из устной речи перетекли в письменную. Поэтому пользователи сетей, блогеры описывают проблемы, ситуации, с которыми приходится сталкиваться ежедневно, как приходится разрешать привычные и новые проблемы, приспосабливаться к ним, пересматривать и менять свои стереотипы.

По четырем из девяти критериев- актуальность, область распространения, использование и способ передачи-оба вида пословиц похожи, по одному критерию- тематике, анти пословицы «обходят» традиционные, т.к.. кроме общих тем, например, «дом», «деньги», «дружба», «любовь», « брак», они описывают политическую жизнь, коррупцию, феминизм, качество обслуживания, компьютерную зависимость и т.п., т.е. их тематика шире.

По четырем критериям пословицы различаются.

Это дает нам основание предположить, что пословицы и анти пословицы существуют «параллельно», не пересекаясь и не составляя конкуренцию друг другу. Каждый вид занимает свое место в языке, выполняет свои функции и находит широкое применение. (9)

III. Заключение.

Таким образом, в ходе написания научно-исследовательской работы нами была изучена научная и методическая литература, рассмотрены определение, способы образования, тематика и функции пословиц анти пословиц в английском языке, изучены причины, их классификации, роль в английском языке и практическое применение. Также проведен сравнительный анализ традиционных и анти пословиц.

Цель была достигнута: мы узнали и исследовали антипословицы, и то как они проявляются и употребляются

Поставленные задачи были реализованы:

- 1. Мы рассмотрели, что значит понятие «антипословица» в целом.;
- 2. Мы изучили причины появления антипословиц в английском языке;
- 3. Мы изучили способы образования антипословиц;
- 4. Мы найшли их примеры на английском языке.

Результаты нашей работы показали:

- 1. богатство и особенность английского языка- в пословицах, в которых заключен глубинный смысл и народная мудрость, уходящая своими корнями в далекое прошлое. В них мы можем увидеть культуру, традиции и историю народа, познать, что такое добро и зло, Ценность пословиц заключается в краткости изложения и емкости передаваемого смысла
- 2. в последнее время в мире происходит много изменений во всех сферах жизни, язык приспосабливается к этим изменениям и реагирует на них. Это вызвало рост активизации анти пословиц как необходимость смены системы ценностей, протест против банального здравого смысла и назидательного тона традиционной "народной мудрости", как веселая языковая игра
- 3. и традиционные, и анти пословицы часто используются, потому что блистательно иллюстрируют и жизненный опыт и предыдущих поколений, современности, оживляют устную и письменную речь, делают ее насыщенной, понятной и запоминающейся
- 4. пословицы и анти пословицы используются широко и постоянно- в литературе, СМИ, рекламе, речи экономистов, политиков и т.д
- 5. употребление анти пословиц связано с определенным событием или явлением в жизни общества, но часто они затрагивают узкий круг людей, и мы полагаем., что это определяет кратковременное существование анти пословиц, в отличие от традиционных, значение и смысл которых понятен любому
